## This Week's Readings:

Day 32 | Sunday | February 1 | Exodus 1:1 - 2:25; 1 Chronicles 6:1-3a; Exodus 3:1 - 4:17 | Israel in Egypt; Joseph's linage; Israel became too numerous - placed into slavery; the more they were oppress, the more they multiplied; king issued population limit to Hebrew midwives; God was kind to the midwives; throw the newborn boys into the Nile - keep the girls; Moses - born, raised in king's house, when he was 40 he saw how his people were treated, murdered Egyptian, fled to Midan, found a wife - Zipporah, had a child; Israel's suffering heard by God; Moses' famly tree; Moses see burning bush of God at 80 years old; YHWH is God's name - timeless - I AM; signs; God mad at Moses - Aaron enlisted to be the talker.

Day 33 | Monday | February 2 | Exodus 4:18 - 7:13 | Moses takes his family to Egypt; God says Moses will perform miracles and wonders but the King will not negotiate; Aaron is called by God to be with Moses; They speak to the elders of Israel; Moses and Aaron speak to the King; King increases the hardship to Hebrew slaves; Moses asks God, "Why?", God says, "I am the God of your ancestors, I will be their liberator."; genealogy of Moses and Aaron; Aaron's staff becomes a snake - Moses was 80, Aaron 83. King would not let the people go.

Day 34 | Tuesday | February 3 | Exodus 7:14 - 9:35 | Pharaoh will not listen to God and God's message of liberation; his magicians are doing the same acts and he does not listen to God. Plague 1: Blood; Plague 2: frogs; Plague 3: gnats; Plague 4: flies; Plague 5: death of livestock; Plague 6: boils; Plague 7: hail.

Day 35 | Wednesday | February 4 | Exodus 10:1 - 12:51 | Plagues 8,9, 10 of Locusts, Darkness, Egypt's first born; First Passover; Israel's leaves Egypt; more instructions concerning Passover.

Day 36 | Thursday | February 5 | Exodus 13:1 - 15:27 | Consecration of first born; God leads the throng of Israel toward the Red Sea to avoid war with the king of Egypt; Army goes after them; Escape through the Red Sea; pillar of cloud and fire following no blocks Egypt; escape through sea - Egypt follows and is drowned; Moses sings of deliverance; Miriam sings with the women; clean water

Day 37 | Friday | February 6 | Exodus 16:1 - 19:25 | Complaining about the food - God provides; Water? - God provides; Israelites defeat the Amalekites; Father-in-law Jethro visits Moses and gives advise; on the 1st day of the 3rd month YHWH (the Lord) reveals YHWH at Sinai and talks with Moses.

Day 38 | Saturday | February 7 | Exodus 20:1-22:15 | Ten Commandments; Why 10?; don't make any gods; treat servants fairly; injury and personal property adjudication; property rights
